

DYN

DYN is yet another byte encoded language for describing [data definition](#) statements. The [DSQL](#) subsystem in Firebird/InterBase® passes parsed DDL statements to a component that emits DYN and then to the [Y-Valve](#) that interprets DYN and modify directly system tables that are “active” by design.
