GDML, or Groton Data Manipulation Language, is a relational language designed to be written and read by people, like [SQL](#). GDML is the original language of Interbase and still it's supported through an utility known as [QLI](#). It's the equivalent of [DML](#) in SQL, although it exhibits some capabilities of [DDL](#).
