

ibec_Progress

Displays a progress message.

Syntax

```
function ibec_Progress(Mes : string): string;
```

Description

Call `ibec_Progress` function to display a message. The `Msg` parameter is the message [string](#) that appears in the upper status panel of the [SQL Editor](#) or [Script Editor](#). If you're executing an IBEBlock using the [ibescript.exe](#) tool the message will appear on the screen and will be included into log file .

Example

```
execute IBEBlock
returns (table_name varchar(31), irecords integer)
as
begin
  for select rdb$relation_name
    from rdb$relations
    order by rdb$relation_name
    into :table_name
  do
    begin
      ibec_Progress('Counting records of ' || ibec_Trim(table_name));
      execute statement 'select count(*) from ' || ibec_Trim(table_name) into
:irecords;
      suspend;
    end
  end
end
```
