

DROP SEQUENCE

Description

Removes a [sequence](#) or [generator](#) from the [database](#). Its (very small) storage space will be freed for re-use after a [backup-restore](#) cycle. [SEQUENCE](#) is the SQL-compliant term for what InterBase and Firebird have always called a generator. [DROP SEQUENCE](#) is fully equivalent to [DROP GENERATOR](#) and is the recommended syntax from Firebird 2.0 onward.

Syntax

```
DROP SEQUENCE sequence-name
```

Example

```
drop sequence seqtest
```

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
